WNA, Inc. is pleased to announce compliance with regulations enacted by the U. S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) associated with the manufacturing and marketing of products designed and intended primarily for children 12 years of age or younger. The two products classes; Injection Molded Kids Cups and Thermoformed "FunCups™", are certified by a third party testing facility to comply with all requirements of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA).

The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) is an independent federal regulatory agency created by Congress in 1972 under the Consumer Product Safety Act. The agency's mission is to *"protect the public against unreasonable risks of injuries and deaths associated with consumer products"*.

The Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 requires a General Conformity Certificate (GCC) stating that the products have complied with laws, rules, CPSA bans and any regulations. WNA, Inc. has adopted the CPSIA's General Certificate of Conformance, and publishes the document specific to each manufacturing lot for our FunCups™ and Kids' Cup programs. The purpose of the Certificate of Conformance is to provide assurance to our customers that each design has a unique date lot control number to facilitate tracking to the source of origin for all raw materials and that those materials meet or exceed the requirements of the CPSIA.
